In the coming future, the College will incorporate WBA tools into various facets of its training progressively. Given the importance of trainers in the role of upholding the quality of PGME, the College has organised two educational courses in May 2024 for faculty development to help trainers putting

competency-based learning theories into practice. The College Warden, Dr. WL Poon & his team in Education Committee and the Working Group on WBA in Radiology convened by Dr. Kevin Fung deserve our highest praise for their tireless efforts devoted in this important training development.



At the same time, I am thrilled to announce the successful establishment of interventional radiology as a recognized subspecialty of Radiology in February 2024! This significant achievement will undoubtedly benefit our profession and enhance the training of our trainees, providing them with more focused educational pathways and opportunities for advanced practice. The IR Subspecialty Training Programme is scheduled to commence on 1st October 2024. 22nd Asian Oceanian Congress of Radiology (AOCR 2024) in Chinese Taipei, The 6th Asian Radiology Summit (ARS) during Japan Radiology Congress 2024 in Japan. Our College continues to have close collaboration with other organisations like AOSR, AOSNHNR, ASCI, BIR, KSR, BSNR, etc. for various academic and scientific exchange.

While we have been kept busy in resuming our schedule back to normalcy from the Covid Pandemic and engaging in the packed programs of various Radiology activities, we have kept eyeing on the need to cultivate our next generation. Our College's Young Fellows Network (YFN) was formed in November 2017 with the objective to enhance communication between the Young Fellows and the College, to encourage more Young Fellows to contribute to the College and community, to nurture the Young Fellows in professional development and College involvement, as well as to organise activities that are in line with the objectives of the College. Dr. Joyce Chan and Dr. Kelvin Bao were nominated by our College and awarded by the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine to be the Distinguished Young Fellows in 2023.

And remember, while we may not all be able to dive like the gold medalist Quan Hongchan, we can certainly aim to win the gold in teamwork and collaboration! It is with great enthusiasm that I share with you some of the recent milestones and advancements within our College, marking significant progress in radiology training and professional development. Once of the most noteworthy achievements is the successful establishment of Interventional Radiology (IR) as a new clinical subspecialty under our College. This landmark development has been approved by the Education and Accreditation Committee of the Medical Council of Hong Kong, which, at its meeting on 19 January 2024, accepted the recommendation of the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine to include "Interventional Radiology (介入放射科)" in the Specialist Register. At the time of writing this column, we already have 74 college fellows accredited in the subspecialty of IR.

Interventional Radiology has emerged as a cornerstone of minimally invasive, image-guided therapies, offering patients less invasive and more effective treatment options. The formalisation of IR as a subspecialty demonstrates our commitment to advancing medical care and ensuring that our radiologists are equipped to meet the ever-evolving needs of healthcare systems, both locally and globally.

This achievement is the result of years of tireless effort from many individuals, including our council members, subspecialty board members, trainers, and fellows. I would like to take this opportunity to thank everyone involved for their dedication and hard work in laying the groundwork for this milestone. The establishment of this subspecialty is not just an endpoint but a beginning - a call to action for all of us to build on this foundation, nurture talent, and further elevate the standards of interventional radiology practice in Hong Kong.

By formally recognizing Interventional Radiology as a subspecialty, our College aims to:

- Promote Public Awareness: Raise awareness about the vital work of Interventional Radiologists and improve public access to IR services.
- 2. Facilitate Specialised Training: Ensure that radiologists pursuing careers in Interventional Radiology receive the knowledge, skills, and expertise necessary to deliver safe and effective care to our patients.

- Foster Multidisciplinary Collaboration: Enhance collaboration and knowledge exchange between Interventional Radiologists and other medical specialties, encouraging a holistic approach to patient management and treatment planning.
- 4. Elevate Hong Kong's Healthcare Standards:

 Strengthen the reputation of Hong Kong's healthcare system, attract top talent, and encourage research and innovation in this rapidly evolving field.

This achievement is not merely a milestone but a platform for further growth. Let us seize this opportunity to advance the field of Interventional Radiology, both locally and globally, and to integrate it seamlessly into our healthcare system.

As we continue to elevate our training standards, another significant development is the adoption of Workplace-Based Assessment (WBA) into our training curriculum. At the meeting with Training Heads on 19 June 2024, we discussed various updates on training, including WBA, Faculty Development, and the plan for the development of e-Portfolio. We will start off with incorporating Direct Observation of Procedural Skills (DOPS) to higher specialist training and IR subspecialty training. In preparation, dedicated hands-on training sessions for familiarisation with WBA will be jointly arranged with JCIMED of Hong Kong Academy of Medicine.

WBA represents a shift toward more dynamic, real-time, and practical evaluation methods, which emphasize the importance of assessing trainees in their actual clinical environments. This approach allows trainers to provide immediate feedback, identify areas for improvement, and foster a deeper understanding of clinical competencies. By embedding WBA into our

curriculum, we are not merely introducing a new tool but are taking a significant step in the process of **Faculty development**.

Faculty development is an evolving process that requires adaptability, innovation, and a forward-looking mindset. By integrating WBA, we are aligning ourselves with global best practices in medical education and ensuring that our training programs remain relevant and robust. This approach also underscores our commitment to nurturing competent, confident, and compassionate radiologists who are prepared to meet the challenges of modern healthcare.

Moving Forward Together

These developments - the establishment of Interventional Radiology as a subspecialty and the integration of Workplace-Based Assessment - reflect our College's unwavering dedication to excellence in education, training, and professional development. They are also a testament to the collective vision and effort of our members, fellows, and trainees, who continue to uphold the highest standards of radiology practice.

As we look to the future, I encourage all of you to take an active role in shaping the growth and success of these initiatives. Whether through mentorship, active participation in training programs, or contributing to the development of new assessment tools, your involvement will be critical in ensuring the continued success of our College and the profession as a whole.

Let us celebrate these achievements and, at the same time, continue striving for excellence in all aspects of radiology. Together, we can build an even stronger foundation for the future of our specialty.



HKCR 15A Travelling Fellowship 2023 - Overseas Attachment in Musculoskeletal Training at the Oxford University Hospital, Oxford, May 2024

It is my great honor to be awarded the HKCR 15A Travelling Fellowship, supporting my Musculoskeletal overseas training at the Oxford University Hospital in May 2024, which is a valuable experience for me. This program has been a great opportunity for me to enhance my skills, deepen my knowledge and gain exposure in the field of musculoskeletal radiology.

Oxford University Hospital is a tertiary referral centre for various orthopaedics entities, including spine and tumor diseases. The musculoskeletal radiology service provided in Oxford University Hospital was vast, including full lists of ultrasound guided, CT guided and fluoroscopic guided musculoskeletal intervention apart from daily diagnostic service. It included a huge variety of disease entities, including bone and soft tissue tumor, rheumatological diseases and sports imaging. It also provided a lot of educational activities, which included weekly educational lectures and conferences.



Through joining the daily readout sessions with attending doctors and fellows, I learned a lot about imaging findings and presentation of rheumatological diseases and musculoskeletal tumors. Seminar on Nuclear Power Plant & Radioactive Waste Water Disposal, 27th August 2023

A seminar on 'Nuclear Power Plant & Radioactive Waste Water Disposal' was held on 27 August 2023 at the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building. The event was organized by the Hong Kong College of Radiologists, convened by Dr. Lilian Leong and Dr. Francis Lee. In view of the increasing concern on the plan to dispose waste water in the Fukushima Nuclear Power Plant by the Japanese authority, the College has promptly initiated such an event to help medical colleagues better prepare for queries from patients and the public.

The seminar attracted over 150 attendants, including radiologists, oncologists and medical physicists. It was an honour to have Prof. Afshin Gangi, Past President of the Cardiovascular and Interventional Radiological Society of Europe (CIRSE), to share his personal experience in France, when the Chernobyl incident happened in 1986. His sharing highlighted the worries of the public after a nuclear incident. The seminar also invited senior medical physicists from local hospitals, who are experts in radiation safety, to give an overview on the evolution of nuclear



power technologies, and the handling of radiation emergencies. The seminar then moved on to discuss the radiation risk arising from the proposal of the Fukushima Daiichi Nuclear Power Station, to dispose of its radioactive waste water in storage to the open sea. An account of the Nuclear Plant incident caused by the 2011 Tohoku Earthquake and Tsunami, the summary of the IAEA report on the radioactive waste water disposal plan, and the potential radiation risk involved, was also presented.



Q & A session was conducted at the end, with enthusiastic attendants raising questions about potential radiation risk on Hong Kong citizens. Although it was by no means to give definitive answers to all questions, the local experts, consisted of a panel of senior medical physicists, tried their best to interpret the information on hand, and to explain and analyse the situation. It was hoped that medical colleagues could gain more insight into the incident, and be better equipped with knowledge that can help them advise their patients and the public.



The 21st Annual Scientific Meeting of Asian and Oceanic Society for Paediatric Radiology (AOSPR 2023), 2nd - 3nd September 2023

The AOSPR Annual Scientific Meeting 2023 was successfully held at the Hong Kong Academy of Medicine Jockey Club Building on 2nd and 3rd September 2023. The untimely visit of super typhoon Saola on the days approaching the meeting forced the organising committee to be quick on its feet and we adapted a virtual format for the first day. Thanks to the tireless efforts of the organizing committee, helpers and faculty members, the meeting was able to seamlessly transition into physical format on the second day, bringing a fruitful conclusion as participants celebrated over a joyous congress banquet.



The meeting brought together more than 300 healthcare professionals, composing of international and local specialists in paediatric radiology from 20 countries/regions around the world. Lectures and multidisciplinary symposiums were delivered by both local and international faculties. We had the honour of hosting over 30 international and over 20 local faculty members who shared their knowledge and gave us insight into each of their respective subspecialised areas. There were lectures by outstanding speakers from around the world which covered a range of topics and anatomical regions including cardiovascular, nephro-urologicial, neurological, chest, abdominal, musculoskeletal and head

and neck imaging. There was a special focus on topics such as foetal and post-mortem imaging, paediatric oncology, and quality and safety in paediatric radiology. For those that preferred a more hands-on and interactive learning experience, the

ultrasound workshops held on day 2 gave participants a chance to learn from experts on tips and tricks in ultrasound-guided vascular access (such as peripherally inserted central catheters and Port-a-caths) and ultrasound-guided biopsies. The meeting received a substantial number of abstract submissions, with 50 poster presentations and 58 oral presentations selected and conducted in both proffered paper and rapid fire formats.

While the social programme originally scheduled on 1^{st} and 2^{nd} of September had to be cancelled due to typhoon Saola, we were able to reschedule the congress banquet thanks to the efforts of the organizing committee. As per AOSPR tradition, it was a night of good food and full of laughter, singing and performances by delegates from multiple countries.



The 2-day conference not only facilitated the learning and sharing of knowledge in paediatric radiology, it also brought together colleagues and friends from around the world after years of isolation during the COVID pandemic, encouraging network building in the field and fostering foundations for future collaborations. The Uro-Oncology Asia 2024 was successfully held on 13-14th January at JW Marriott Hotel Hong Kong. This scientific meeting was organised by the Hong Kong Society of Uro-Oncology (HKSUO) and supported by 11 healthcare professional organisations in Hong Kong and Macau.
