Radiology Integrated Training Initiative (R-ITI)

The Radiology Integrated Training Initiative (R-ITI) is a project jointly developed by The Royal College of Radiologists (RCR) and Department of Health in United Kingdom since 2002. It consists of an electronic learning database (eLD) that comprises of approximately 800 sessions of e-learning tutorials (organized into 15 modules) and more than 600 hours of self directed web base learning. Each session has clearly stated learning objective that is matched to the RCR syllabus. The content was developed with a specific purpose to cover the core curriculum of the first 3 years of clinical radiology training as laid down by the RCR. Detailed validation and editing processes are in place to guarantee the quality and uniformity. It is an interactive learning environment and incorporates self-assessment by the trainees and allows the trainers to monitor the progress of their trainees. A validated case archive (VCA) would compliment the e-LD. It is now available to all radiology trainees in the UK and 3 pilot sites have been set up in the Australasia. A subscription charge is applicable to overseas users to cover the expenditure to maintain and update the content of the site.
