- Candidates may apply for this Autumn 2021 Joint Examination only if they are a trainee currently working in a local training centre in Hong Kong.
- Due to the ongoing COVID-19 outbreak, social distancing rules and cleaning guidelines in line with the HKSAR Government Guidance will be enforced in each examination venue. All candidates must adhere to such rules and guidelines issued by HKCR. **Should any candidate feel unwell or display symptoms they should not attend the examination.**
- Changes to exam delivery have been put in place to mitigate against exam cancellation due to COVID-19. While the RCR & HKCR have done its best to achieve this, it is still possible that an exam may need to be cancelled, or a region may not be able to run the exam, due to local constraints or updated government guidance.

For the examination fees to HKCR, cheque(s) made payable to “**Hong Kong College of Radiologists**” in Hong Kong Dollar should be submitted with the application form. Upon final approval of application by RCR, candidates would be advised to log into the RCR portal in order to make and pay for the RCR portion of the examination.
- Candidates passing the examination will be expected to attend the Admission Ceremony.
