NOTES

- Candidates wanting to take the Joint exam must apply to the Hong Kong College of Radiologists in the first instance. They should read the <u>Guidance Notes for Examination Applicants</u> & <u>Regulations for</u> <u>Examinations</u> carefully before submitting an application and ensure this is done before the designated closing date as no late applications will be considered.
- 2. Examination Fees should be paid separately to BOTH Hong Kong College of Radiologists and The Royal College of Radiologists. Candidates wishing to have the option to attempt both parts (A and B) must make two separate payments with their application form: one for the Joint Final (Part A) Examination and the other for the Joint Final (Part B) Examination (see above). Part B applications will be processed only after a candidate has passed Part A. The Joint FRCR Part A Examination cannot be taken alone without Part B. Those who want to take the Part A Examination as a standalone examination must contact the Examinations Office at RCR. For the examination fees to HKCR, cheque(s) / bank draft(s) made payable to "Hong Kong College of Radiologists" in Hong Kong Dollar should be submitted with the application form.

Upon final approval of application by RCR, candidates will be manually booked in for the RCR portion of the exam by the RCR Exams team and sent a link to pay for the RCR portion of the examination.

- 3. The Final FRCR (Part B) Examination comprises a 12-station assessment across three examination days. Despite the change in examination delivery, all responses given to examiners should reflect a non-COVID-19 environment. All information relating to exam delivery and candidate resources can be found on the <u>RCR website</u>
- 4. Candidates who successfully pass both parts of the Final exam will be expected to attend the Admission Ceremony.
