**NOTES**

1. **Candidates may apply for this Autumn 2021 Joint Examination only if they are a trainee currently working in a local training centre in Hong Kong.**
2. Due to the ongoing COVID-19 outbreak, social distancing rules and cleaning guidelines in line with the HKSAR Government Guidance will be enforced in each examination venue. All candidates must adhere to such rules and guidelines issued by HKCR. **Should any candidate feel unwell or display symptoms they should not attend the examination.**
3. In light of the continuing COVID-19 pandemic, adjustments must be made on how to conduct the Joint Final (Part B) Examination for the remainder of 2021. Both clinical and oral components will be conducted virtually at a local venue rather than in person. Please refer to RCR website for details: <https://www.rcr.ac.uk/clinical-oncology/exams>
4. Despite the change in clinical examination delivery, **all responses given to examiners should reflect a non-COVID-19 environment.**
5. Please read the [Guidance Notes for Examination Applicants](#) & [Regulations for Examinations](#) carefully before submitting an application, which contain important information on how to make a successful application.
6. It is the responsibility of each candidate to ensure that their application has reached the Examinations Office by the published closing date. Late applications will **NOT** be accepted under any circumstances.
7. Examination Fees should be paid separately to **BOTH** Hong Kong College of Radiologists and The Royal College of Radiologists. Candidates wishing to have the option to attempt both parts (A and B) must make two separate payments with their application form: one for the Joint Final (Part A) Examination and the other for the Joint Final (Part B) Examination (see above). Part B applications will be processed only after a candidate has passed Part A. The Joint FRCR Part A Examination cannot be taken alone without Part B. Those who wants to take the Part A Examination as a standalone examination must contact the Examinations Office at RCR. For the examination fees to HKCR, cheque(s) made payable to **“Hong Kong College of Radiologists”** in Hong Kong Dollar should be submitted with the application form. Upon final approval of application by RCR, candidates would be advised to log into the RCR portal in order to make and pay for the RCR portion of the examination.
8. For the Joint Final (Part B) Examination, candidates should submit **four recent passport-sized photographs** with their application form. The candidate’s name should be written on the reverse of the photographs.
9. Candidates passing both parts of the examination will be expected to attend the Admission Ceremony.
