



Please note that all refunds will be issued only after the meeting.

If the meeting is cancelled due to extenuating circumstances (i.e. outbreak of diseases including highly infectious diseases causing health hazard to human lives, or from other causes [apart from adverse weather conditions] which are beyond reasonable control and could not reasonably be expected by the Hong Kong College of Radiologists), **the registration fee, less the 10% bank charge and administration fee, would be reimbursed at the Hong Kong College of Radiologists’ discretion.** Hong Kong College of Radiologists will announce if any refund is available in due course after the announcement of the cancellation of the meeting.
