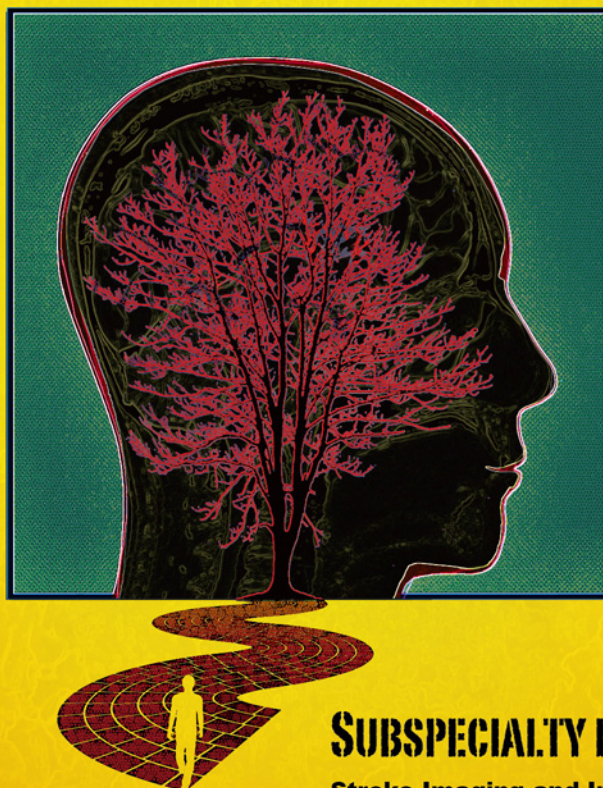

Away from the maddening pace of the city, this tour offers a glimpse of the rural and traditional Hong Kong. A stop at a fish-farming zone at Sam Mun Tsai is next followed by lunch served at one of the famous restaurant in Sha Tin.
